SUBJECT: UPDATE TO THE NATIONAL CRIME INFORMATION CENTER (NCIC)  
COVID-19 GUIDANCE

On March 30, 2020, the FBI's Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provided COVID-19 guidance regarding NCIC Wanted Person records and locate and validation procedures. This update is to inform NCIC users the aforementioned COVID-19 guidance is no longer applicable. Current NCIC policies and procedures should be followed regarding extradition and the placement of Locate messages. For CJIS Systems Agencies programmed for online validations, NCIC will resume automatic purging of records beginning on Sunday, October 2, 2022, with any unvalidated records from the August 2022 Validation File.
