The Executive Committee will conduct an evidentiary hearing on an appeal from a decision of the Administrator of the Division of Law Enforcement Services (Acting Director of the Bureau of Training and Standards), to restrict a law enforcement recruit's re-enrollment in a 720-hour law enforcement training academy in Wisconsin until May 1, 2024. Following conclusion of the evidentiary hearing, the Executive Committee may entertain a motion to go into closed session pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.85(1)(a), (b), and/or (g), for the purposes of deliberating on the case, considering licensing of the public employee involved in the evidentiary hearing, and/or conferring with legal counsel about potential litigation related to the evidentiary hearing. The Executive Committee will reconvene in open session if closed proceedings have occurred.
